# WEEKLY COUP UPDATE BY THE KACHIN ALLIANCE

### SEPTEMBER 24 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2022

his week, fighting between the Burma Army (BA) and the joint forces of the Kachin Independence Army (KIA) was reported in Shan State (<u>Namtu</u>, and <u>Hseni</u>). Over the week, there were clashes between the BA and PDFs in Sagaing Region (<u>Indaw</u>, <u>Kale</u>, <u>Mawlaik</u>, <u>Mingin</u>, <u>Myaung</u>, <u>Shwebo</u>, and <u>Tamu</u>), Chin State (<u>Matupi</u>), Mon State (<u>Kyaikto</u>), and Magway Region (<u>Myaing</u>). Additionally, the BA and its alliances clashed with the joint forces of the KNLA/KNDO in Karen State (<u>Kyainseikgyi</u>); and with the AA in Rakhine State (<u>Buthidaung</u>, <u>Ponnagyun</u>, <u>Kyauktaw</u>, and <u>Maungdaw</u>). Furthermore, the BA's aerial attacks were reported in Rakhine State (<u>Maungdaw</u>, and <u>Minbya</u>).

The ambush attacks on BA's troops, BA's checkpoints, BA's bases and military convoy/vehicles were reported in Sagaing Region (Ayadaw, Myinmu, Monywa, Chaung-U, Tamu, Taze, and Wetlet), Karenni State (Demoso, Hpruso, and Loikaw), Karen State (Kyainseikgyi), Shan State (Mongton, Manton, and Namhkan), Magway Region (Myaing, Pauk, and Saw), Rakhine State (Rathedaung), Tanintharyi Region (Palaw, Tanintharyi, and Yebyu), Mandalay Region (Madaya, and Thabeikkyin), and Mon State (Thanbyu-Ye Highway, and Ye). This week, violence against regime informants and collaborators, and around government offices and junta's assets was reported in Yangon Region (Mingalardon and Ahlone-ward administration office, Yangon-police, North Dagon-ward administrator, Dagon Myothit South-ward administrator, Hlaing-government office building, and Shwepyithar-ward administration office), Mon State (Ye-police, informant, government office, Thaton-militia member, and Kyaikto-militia member and his wife), and Bago Region (Paukkhaung-government office).

# Humanitarian Crisis and Human Rights Violations

- Over the week, bomb explosion by unknown groups were reported in Mandalay Region (<u>Mahaaungmyay</u>).
- Between September 16 and 29, in Taze Township, Sagaing Region, <u>the regime</u> destroyed over 6000 civilian homes.
- On September 24, in Salingyi Township, Sagaing Region, <u>the BA started burning</u> <u>down villages</u> located on the northern part of the town. On that same day in Taze Township, <u>the BA burned down seven villages.</u>
- On September 24, in Ye Township, Mon State, <u>security forces shot and killed a</u> local man for going out at night.
- On September 25, in Mogaung Township, Kachin State, <u>security forces arrested</u> the local chair of the National League for Democracy (NLD) Party at Samaw Village.
- On September 25, in Yebyu Township, Tanintharyi Region, the BA marched into the villages in the area and arrested about 20 civilians. As of September 29, none of them have been released.
- On September 26, in Pakokku Township, Magway Region, the BA arrested a young male civilian for alleged connections to the PDF.
- On September 27, in Tilin Township, Sagaing Region, the BA burned down four houses in Ponenar Village and arrested about 30 civilians.

### **Crisis in Rakhine State**

- Between September 19 to 27, in Kyauktaw Township, the BA continuously fired artillery shells in the area, destroying <u>multiple homes</u> and injuring locals including an 8-year old child.
- On September 25, in Mrauk-U Township, security forces arrested a local charity volunteer and his brother for no apparent reason.
- On September 26, in Rathedaung Township, the <u>BA randomly fired artillery</u> <u>shells</u> in Manyin Taung Village, forcing locals to flee to safety.
- On September 26, in Minbya Township, the BA conducted airbombarment in the area after AA attacked two BA ships. <u>The airstrike killed two civilians.</u>
- On September 26, in Sittwe Township, security forces arrested a motorcycle taxi driver for no apparent reason.

- On September 27, in Myitkyina Township, Kachin State, the regime security office hung <u>a vinyl sign that read "mines planted"</u> indicating that there are mines planted around the offices as security.
- On September 27, in Monywa Township, Sagaing Region, <u>in Htanaung Daw</u> <u>Village</u>, the BA forces <u>burned down about five houses and arrested about 50</u> <u>civilians.</u>
- On September 27, in Shan State, the regime ordered the displaced camps in Northern Shan State to shut down before the end of October. The people living in the camps are worried about the order because they have nowhere else to go.
- On September 27, in Kale Township, Sagaing Region, <u>the BA arrested over 20</u> <u>civilians including two underage youths.</u>
- On September 27, in Pauk Township, Magway Region, the BA <u>burned down</u> houses in Tayetkan Village and arrested 15 civilians including a one-year old.
- On September 28, in Pauk Township, Magway Region, <u>the BA burned down 8</u> <u>civilian homes and the Tayatkan police station.</u>
- On September 28, in Indaw Township, Sagaing Region, the BA <u>burned down four</u> <u>houses in Aungkone Village and arrested some elderlies</u> who could not escape. They also <u>shot and killed a 20-year old civilian</u>.
- On September 28, in Yinmarbin Township, Sagaing Region, <u>the BA burned down</u> <u>three houses in Htanzin Village.</u>
- On September 28, in Demoso Township, Karenni State, artillery shells fired by the BA <u>destroyed a Christian church and severely injured a 19-year old civilian.</u>
- On September 28, in Tamu Township, Sagaing Region, <u>security forces arrested a</u> <u>civilian</u> for posting anti-regime posts on social media.
- On September 28 and 29, in Mohnyin Township, Kachin State, <u>security forces</u> <u>used bulldozers to destroy two civilian homes</u> for allegedly supporting the PDF.
- On September 29, in Myitkyina Township, Kachin State, <u>security forces arrested a</u> <u>government administrator</u> for unknown reasons.
- On September 29, in Indaw Township, Sagaing Region, <u>the BA shot and killed</u> <u>two PDF members and two civilians.</u>
- On September 29, in Hinthada Township, Ayeyarwady Region, <u>security forces</u> <u>confiscated the house of Maung Maung San</u>, a former NLD party administrator, accusing him of supporting the PDF.
- On September 29, in Ye Township, Mon State, security forces shot and <u>killed a</u> <u>local NLD party supporter</u>.
- On September 29, in Tigyaing Township, Sagaing Region, <u>the BA's artillery shell</u> <u>killed a female civilian</u> from Paukkone Village and injured three others.
- On September 30, in Myaing Township, Magway Region, a landmine setup by the BA exploded, <u>killing a 5 year old child</u>.
- On September 30, in Loikaw Township, Karenni State, <u>an unknown group</u> <u>attacked a Myanmar National Airline (MNA) flight</u> carrying 63 passengers, resulting in a male passenger getting injured.

### On September 26, in Myebon Township, <u>security forces arrested a doctor</u> for transporting medicine.

- On September 28, in Thandwe Township, <u>the BA forcefully evicted locals from</u> <u>Gyaingthar Village and destroyed multiple</u> <u>houses.</u>
- On September 29, in Ponnagyun Township, the BA called business owners, including jewelry store owners, and <u>threatened them not to pay taxes to AA</u> (Arakan Army).
- On September 29, in Mrauk-U Township, the BA arrested 23 civilians and burned down 3 huts.
- On September 29, in Mrauk-U Township, <u>a</u> <u>landmine explosion fatally injured an 18-year old civilian.</u> He passed away while receiving treatment at a local hospital. In the same township, the artillery shell fired by the BA<u>injured two young children</u> in Maungswe Village.

## **Other updates**

- On September 17, <u>a prisoner from Oh-Bo Prison in Mandalay Region passed away</u> due to the lack of medical care in the prison.
- On September 27, in Yangon Region, <u>Insein Prison Court sentenced actress Nang Mwe San to 6 years in prison</u> under the electronic communication law Section 33a. She was arrested on August 5 for posting inappropriate pictures of herself online.
- On September 30, in Myeik Township, Tanintharyi Region, <u>the regime released 57 political prisoners</u> who were arrested during anti-coup protests.
- According to a report from the National Unity Government (NUG), <u>the BA committed a total 77 crimes of arson, illegal arrests</u>, and <u>killings</u>. Another report from NUG recently stated that since the coup, <u>the BA had arrested 363 children (under age 18) and killed 234</u>.
